

Morwellham Camping & Festival Information, Terms & Conditions Beer & Music Festival

Can I bring my dog?

We are actively discouraging dogs from this event, but if you wish to bring a dog there will be a fee of £3.95 per dog. Dogs are not allowed into the History of Chocolate or the Bakery.

Can I camp for only part of the festival?

Yes, camping is priced per pitch per night, tickets need to be purchased online in advance.

Can I sleep in my car?

Any vehicle being slept in overnight will need to pay for a pitch at £10 per night, please also ensure that you purchase the correct evening and day tickets to suit your stay.

Can I bring my own alcohol?

Bringing alcohol into the festival is strictly prohibited, however, a small amount is allowed within the campsite. We will confiscate any alcohol that is deemed more than appropriate for personal consumption. Please do not bring any glass onto the site.

Can I get a ticket refund?

Ticket sales are non-refundable.

Do you have disabled access?

Due to the nature of our site, there are some uneven pathways, steps and slopes. Disabled toilets are located in reception and in the village, reception will be open during day opening hours, the village toilets will remain open for the duration of the evening entertainment.

When do I get my tickets?

We do not send out physical tickets. When you buy your ticket online, your digital ticket is sent to the email address you provided at the checkout. Simply print this email or save it to your phone and bring it with you, along with some identification.

When do I get my wristband?

Tickets are exchanged for wristbands, when you check in on your arrival to the festival.

Can I leave the site during the day and come back?

Yes, people, cars and campervans can come and go throughout the festival weekend providing you are wearing a valid wristband on re-entering the site.

Where do I camp?

We have a small field next to our carpark for tents and caravans. Campervans and motorhomes will have use of a designated area of our carpark. There are no special facilities such as electricity or waste disposal. Toilets, showers and fresh water are all available within the campsite/carpark area. Evening meals will be available to purchase from the festival area. Breakfast will be available to purchase from the Ship Inn from 9am.

When are my tickets valid for?

Beer & Music Festival tickets are valid from 10am on Friday 29th May until 10am on Saturday 30th May. Campers may arrive from 10am on Friday 29th May and depart by 5pm on Saturday 30th May.

Can we have a fire at our campsite?

No fires or BBQs are allowed in the campsite, gas stoves are fine. Toilets, showers and fresh water are all available within the campsite/carpark area.

Children (Under 18)

Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Children are not permitted to consume alcohol at any time, during the festival or within the campsite.
