

Morwellham 2026 Camping, Concerts & Festivals information, Terms & Conditions.

1. Can I bring Children? Please be advised we believe this event is not suitable for children.
2. Can I bring my dog? No dogs are permitted at this event other than official Service dogs.
3. Can I sleep in my car? The Car Park will close 1 hour after the event any vehicle being slept in overnight will need to pay for a camping pitch and be pre booked at least 24 hrs prior to the event.
4. Can I bring my own alcohol? Bringing alcohol into the festival is strictly prohibited, however, a small amount is allowed within the campsite. We will confiscate any alcohol that is deemed more than appropriate for personal consumption. Please do not bring any glass onto the site.
- 5 Can I bring my own food and drink? Only food and drink purchased on site is allowed in the event arena.
6. Can I bring chairs? Chairs are not permitted within the arena but can be used on the campsite.
7. Can I get a ticket refund? Ticket sales are only refundable if the event is officially cancelled.
8. Do you have disabled access? Due to the nature of our site, there are some uneven pathways, steps and slopes. Disabled toilets are located in the village.

10. When do I get my tickets? We do not send out physical tickets. When you buy your ticket online, your digital ticket is sent to the email address you provided at the checkout. Simply print this email or save it to your phone and bring it with you, along with some identification.
11. When do I get my wristband? Tickets are exchanged for wristbands when you check in on your arrival to the festival.
12. Can I leave the site during the day and come back? Yes, people, cars and campervans can come and go throughout the day providing you are wearing a valid wristband.
