

Morwellham Camping & Festival Information, Terms & Conditions Mad Dog Mcrea

Can I bring my dog?

No dogs are permitted at this event other than Service dogs..

Can I sleep in my car?

Any vehicle being slept in overnight will need to pay for a camping pitch at £10 per person per night.

Can I bring my own alcohol?

Bringing alcohol into the festival is strictly prohibited, however, a small amount is allowed within the campsite. We will confiscate any alcohol that is deemed more than appropriate for personal consumption. Please do not bring any glass onto the site.

Can I get a ticket refund?

Ticket sales are non-refundable.

Do you have disabled access?

Due to the nature of our site, there are some uneven pathways, steps and slopes. Disabled toilets are located in reception and in the village, reception will be open during day opening hours, the village toilets will remain open for the duration of the evening entertainment.

I've lost my ticket! What do I do?

When do I get my tickets?

We do not send out physical tickets. When you buy your ticket online, your digital ticket is sent to the email address you provided at the checkout. Simply print this email or save it to your phone and bring it with you, along with some identification.

When do I get my wristband?

Tickets are exchanged for wristbands, when you check in on your arrival to the festival.

Can I leave the site during the day and come back?

Yes, people, cars and campervans can come and go throughout the day providing you are wearing a valid wristband on re-entering the site.

Camping facilities?

There are no special facilities such as electricity or waste disposal. Toilets, showers and fresh water are all available.

When are my tickets valid for?

Mad Dog Mcrea tickets are only valid on the evening of Friday 26th May and gates for the concert will open at 6pm. If you have purchased tickets inclusive of camping you can check into the camp site from 12pm on 26th May and The Ship Inn will be open for food and drinks from 12pm to midnight on 26th May and breakfast will be available to purchase from the Ship Inn from 9am on 27th May. Check out of the camp site is by 2pm on 27th May.

Can we have a fire at our campsite?

No fires or BBQs are allowed in the campsite, gas stoves are fine. Toilets, showers and fresh water are all available within the campsite/carpark area.

Children (Under 18)

Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Children are not permitted to consume alcohol at any time, during the festival or within the campsite.
